### Referral

### Application

Your therapist applies for Whaikaha - Ministry of Disabled People funding from Enable New Zealand

### Solution

If funding is approved, **basic** equipment and modifications (e.g. shower stools or hand rails) are provided as soon as possible.



**Complex** equipment or housing solutions (e.g. adjustable beds, ramps and power wheelchairs) may take longer to provide.



### Clinical Advisory Service

Enable New Zealand's clinical advisory services works with therapists to find the most appropriate solution.



The funding criteria is set by **Whaikaha**. Whaikaha is not always able to provide funding for all your needs.



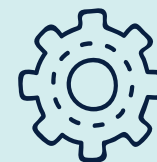
### Dispatch

Most equipment is dispatched from one of our warehouses in Hamilton, Palmerston North and Christchurch. Sometimes it comes directly from our suppliers.



### Trial

Your therapist may trial the equipment with you to make sure it works for you.
